# Our Scope Emissions

Built on GHG Protocol

## Scope One

Scope 1 GHG emissions include emissions associated with natural gas and onsite fuel usage, and fuel used by our company fleet vehicles. They are calculated using a volume-based approach using the Carbon Trust Calculator. Compared to FY23, our Scope 1 emissions in FY24 have decreased by 5% however in real terms there has been an increase due to the number of fleet vehicles we are using. We are increasing our efforts to transition away from combustion engine vehicles to electric vehicles.

## Scope Two

Scope 2 GHG emissions include indirect emissions from the generation of purchased electricity consumed by the company. These are calculated using the location-based method and emissions factors from the Carbon Trust Calculator. Our commitment to using renewable energy sources has resulted in a 7% reduction in Scope 2 emissions compared to FY23.

## Scope Three

Scope 3 GHG emissions encompass all other indirect emissions that occur in the value chain of the company, including both upstream and downstream emissions. This includes categories such as business travel, employee commuting, waste disposal, and the production of purchased goods and services. To accurately measure and report on Scope 3 emissions, we are collaborating with our suppliers and other stakeholders to gather comprehensive data particularly around the carbon offset of our services to our customers.
